**For whom?** Any junior researcher and PhD student currently working in the field of **energy economics** and tackling the broader themes of

- Social and/or technological innovation in the energy transition
- Behavioural aspects in energy and climate policy
- Integrated modelling of energy and resource efficiency
- Energy, climate and macroeconomic relationships
- Novel methodologies and modelling techniques

is invited to participate. Registrations as mere attendees are welcome but kindly asked to be submitted until 24<sup>th</sup> April 2020.

#### How does it work?

- a. Please submit an extended abstract including the chapters "overview, methods, results, conclusions, bibliography" (max. 3 pages, Arial 11pt, line spacing 1.3) until **21<sup>st</sup> February 2020** as pdf to [aaeephd@energieinstitut-linz.at](mailto:aaeephd@energieinstitut-linz.at). Acceptance notification will be sent by **6<sup>th</sup> March 2020**.
- b. After a positive evaluation, you will be invited to submit a full paper to complete your PhD Day registration.
- c. Another student, as well as a senior researcher, will then review your paper. In return, you review a colleague's paper.
- d. You present your work at the PhD Day and obtain extended feedback from your reviewers helping to **get your paper journal ready**.
- e. Enjoy a convivial evening of networking and drinks (18:00-22:00, at your own expenses).

**How much?** The participation including provisions is free of charge. The best presentation will be awarded.
