How does it work?

- a. Please submit an extended abstract including the chapters "overview, methods, results, conclusions, bibliography" (max. 3 pages, Arial 11pt, line spacing 1.3) until 21st February 2020 as pdf to <u>aaeephd@energieinstitut-linz.at.</u> Acceptance notification will be sent by 6th March 2020.
- b. After a positive evaluation, you will be invited to submit a full paper to complete your PhD Day registration.
- c. Another student, as well as a senior researcher, will then review your paper. In return, you review a colleague's paper.
- d. You present your work at the PhD Day and obtain extended feedback from your reviewers helping to **get your paper journal ready**.
- e. Enjoy a convivial evening of networking and drinks (18:00-22:00, at your own expenses).

How much? The participation including provisions is free of charge. The best presentation will be awarded.
