Full paper: 31st July 2021

For whom? Any junior researcher and PhD student currently working in the field of **energy economics** and tackling the broader themes of

Energy & Climate policy in the post-COVID-19 era

- Integrated modelling and role of renewables in future energy networks
- Electric vehicles and fuels of the future (Hydrogen, Fuel cells, Biofuels)
- Economic analysis of smart buildings and the energy community concept
- Socioeconomic and societal aspects of accelerated energy innovation & technology diffusion

is invited to participate. Registrations as mere attendees are welcome but kindly asked to be submitted until 31st August 2021.

How does it work?

- a. Please upload an extended abstract including the chapters "overview, methods, results, conclusions, bibliography" (in English, max. 2 pages, Arial 10pt) by 20th June 2021 to https://iewt2021.eeg.tuwien.ac.at. The acceptance notification will be sent out by 30th June 2021.
- b. In case of a positive evaluation, you will be invited to submit a full paper to complete your PhD Day registration.
- c. Another PhD student, as well as a senior researcher, will then review your paper and, in return, you review a colleague's paper.
- d. You present your work at the PhD Day and obtain detailed feedback from your reviewers, thus helping you to **get your paper journal ready**.
- e. You will receive a link and instructions for your online participation prior to the PhD day.

How much? The participation is free of charge. The best presentation will receive a *Best Presentation Award*.
